Below is a list of Suggestions and Items you may need in the event you use the church Volunteer Housing Facility during a Hurricane or other emergency. It is by no means all inclusive. If you have questions or concerns, please discuss them with your family or a member of the church's Disaster Preparedness Committee.

- Create a 72 Hour Emergency Kit to take with you to the church. Update the kit every 6 months to make sure all food, water and medications are fresh and that personal documents and credit cards are up to date.
- o Bring reading material and games for use during a stressful time.
- o Include any other item you feel necessary for your survival.
- Pack the contents in a sturdy, rolling covered plastic storage bin or suit case
